

AWS market share across global cloud services space






AWS is disrupting new markets with industry developments

Emerging AWS-backed technology services are disrupting new markets and creating new product categories

"Driven by maturation of core cloud services, the focus of differentiation is gradually shifting to capabilities that can disrupt digital businesses and operations in enterprises directly. Public cloud services have become so integral that providers are now forced to address social and political challenges, such as sustainability and data sovereignty.

IT leaders who view the cloud as an enabler rather than an end state will be most successful in their digital transformational journeys. The organizations combining cloud with other adjacent, emerging technologies will fare even better."

Recent AWS Partnerships and Announcements (July 2022)




AWS will play a critical role in **Delta Air Lines** digital business transformation with the announcement of a multi-year agreement to serve as the airline's preferred cloud provider. AWS will help Delta unlock technologies and streamline processes beginning in Summer 2022.



AWS introduced **Cloud WAN** in July 2022, a new managed wide area network [WAN] service that connects on-premises data centers, colocation facilities, branch offices, and cloud resources to simplify operating a global network.



AWS Partner **Tech Mahindra** announced the deployment of **VaccineLedger** in June 2022, an AWS SaaS model that leverages AmazonS3, EC2, and Elastic Beanstalk to track counterfeit COVID-19 vaccines with **Pfizer**.

"AWS alone could be worth more than Amazon's entire market cap right now, which means you're essentially getting the retail business for free," said Marko Lazarevic, a US investment analyst at Harris Associates. "At this valuation, you're not taking on much risk buying Amazon for the long term.

Amid a huge opportunity for cloud computing, some analysts see AWS alone being worth more than Amazon's \$1.14-trillion market capitalization. Bloomberg Intelligence says AWS sits in the \$1.5-trillion to \$2-trillion range."

"Amazon invests more money in AI, applying machine learning and AI techniques everywhere it can from Alexa and Echo devices, autonomous Prime Air delivery drones and AWS cloud services to make improvements in inventory management forecasting, merchandising placements and fraud detection.

The benefits to Amazon include retail and AWS Cloud growth and reduced operating costs. Its AWS machine learning and AI services will also lower the cost barrier for smaller business wanting to adopt these technologies. Amazon could use its 30 – 40% market share to cross-sell AI products and grow AWS sales. As AI is a predictive technology that improves as more data is fed into the system, Amazon has a huge competitive advantage with its ability to generate large volumes of data on a global scale."








The Cloud Services Space is Outperforming the Broader Economy
